The events of September 11 provide a stark reminder that disasters are not hypothetical threat scenarios but real world events that can occur quickly and with deadly force. They victimize innocent people, stop the functioning of governments, and damage and disrupt businesses to the extent that many never recover from financial loss.

Besides the cost of site repairs and the replacement of supplies and equipment, a disruption in the ability to earn income may hinder or prevent a business's recovery. The cost per hour of downtime can be significant, as shown in the following table:

Business Type	Cost Per Hour of Downtime*
Brokerage Operation	\$ 6,450,000
Credit Card Authorizations	\$ 2,600,000
ATM Fees	\$ 14,500
Home Catalog Sales	\$ 90,000
Airline Reservations	\$ 89,500
Media Event Ticket Sales	\$ 69,000
