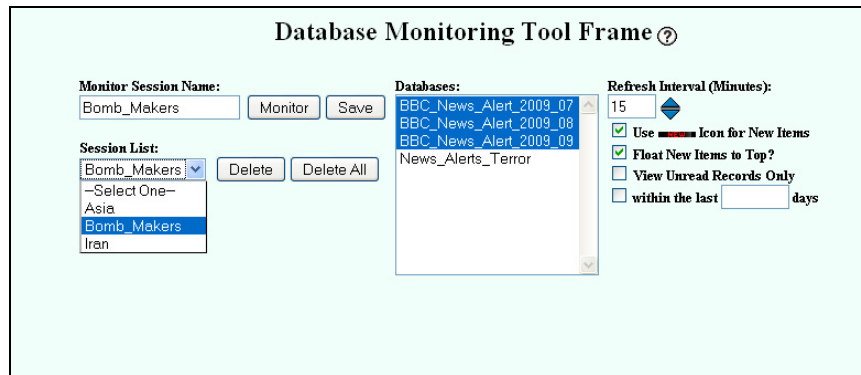

Monitor New Records



Database Monitoring Tool

Route Based Search

The Database Monitor Tool provides analysts a means of monitoring new records for items of interest. Using the Database Monitor, users can create sessions to pair a query with a defined list of databases and a set refresh interval to continuously check for new records matching the user's needs. Results are provided back to the user via the standard Pathfinder Results Window, which permits the use of any of the Pathfinder analytical tools to be used against these results. Users may define multiple monitors to target a variety of topics.

Monitor sessions can be stored for later retrieval. A refresh interval can be defined for each monitor. The refresh interval is the elapsed time between query executions and each execution generates a new result set. This interval is usually set to correspond to the rate at which the target database is refreshed.

Options exist to simplify viewing. Users can elect to float (move) the newest titles to the top of the list or to return only those titles that have not been read. For short refresh times, a pause button is available to prevent the list from changing while records are being read.
