# **Accessing the ITES-3S Contract Vehicle**

- 1. Develop RFP.
- 2. Log on to CHESS IT e-mart site: https://chess.army.mil. Create user account, if first-time user.
- 3. Click on RFQ/RFP button on left side of screen, or online RFP tool button under Services to create an RFP. Only a Contracting Officer or Contract Specialist may create an RFP.
- 4. On the 'Make Your Request' page, select the 'RFP for ITES-3S' radio button.
- 5. Click on the "Create a New Request" button.
- 6. On the next page, Create New Request:
  - Pick the IT service subcategory required and select the contracts (vendors) to receive RFP. The ordering contracting officer will issue a proposal request to all contractors, unless a SB set-aside has been documented.
  - Enter general and specific proposal information, as requested.
  - Click Submit Request button to submit RFP.
- 7. Request Confirmation screen will appear, providing RFP identification and recipient vendors.
- 8. E-mail will be sent to you when:
  - RFP/TOR has been posted on the CHESS portal.
  - Proposal has been submitted IAW the RFP instructions.
  - No Bid response has been posted to CHESS.
- 9. Issue Award.
