Hilary Hageman is Executive Vice President, General Counsel and Corporate Secretary of SAIC, a premier technology integrator driving our nation's technology transformation, with annual revenues of \$7.3 billion and approximately 23,000 employees.

SAIC provides engineering, digital, artificial-intelligence and mission solutions across the defense, space, intelligence, and civilian markets. As SAIC's senior legal advisor, Hageman oversees the legal, internal audit, compliance, ethics, risk-management and government affairs activities of the company.

Hageman served as SAIC's Senior Vice President and Deputy General Counsel until 2019, when she became the general counsel and corporate secretary of Cubic, a technology company serving the defense, intelligence and transportation sectors. At Cubic, Hageman managed the company's law, ethics, contracts, global trade and security functions. She also oversaw all legal aspects of merger and acquisition activities, including the sale of the company in a transaction valued at approximately \$3 billion.

Immediately prior to her return to SAIC in July 2022, Hageman served as executive vice president, general counsel and corporate secretary for a satellite company supporting the defense and aerospace industries. Hageman has also held senior legal roles at CACI, the U.S. Department of Defense and the Intelligence Community.

A proven business leader, Hageman has extensive legal experience in a wide range of areas, including public corporate law, government contracting, mergers and acquisitions, national security law, corporate governance and general legal compliance.

Hageman earned her Master of Laws from Georgetown University, a Juris Doctor from Emory University School of Law and a Bachelor of Arts in history from Vassar College.

Hageman also serves on several non-profit boards, including the Board of Directors of The Women's Center whose mission is to improve the mental health and well-being of all members of our community through counseling, education, and support – regardless of ability to pay.
